Turbulent times

The war in Ukraine that started at the beginning of 2022, has large social, personal and economic consequences worldwide. The economy shows signs of a recession with turmoil on the financial markets and significantly increasing prices. Investors have to deal with disappointing investment results. PCN is no exception.

What does this mean for your pension? Due to these developments, our funding ratio only showed a limited increase. That is why PCN's funding ratio was not sufficient yet to increase your pension as per January 1, 2023. Luckily, PCN had been able to increase your pension by 4% in 2022. If the interest rate continues to develop positively, we expect our funding ratio to increase as well the coming period. It is however important that the investments also show a positive result. Based on the results as at 31 December we can decide to increase the pensions. It is good to know that we as PCN mainly look at the long term. We are aware that the economy can turn favorable or unfavorable along the way. We naturally make adjustments in the short term if necessary. But economic downturns are part of it. We do everything possible to take good care of your pension now and in the future, as affordable and sustainable as possible. We are glad to share the latest developments with you in this newsletter. Survivor's pension

When you pass away, your partner will receive pension from us, for as long as your partner lives. This is the survivor's pension. It is a maximum of 70% of the pension that you receive now. Your current partner is the partner to whom you are married or have entered into a European registered partnership with. The condition is that you were married or have entered into the partnership before the AOV date. Have you been divorced earlier in life? Then your ex partner may be entitled to a special survivor's pension when you pass away. The survivor's pension for your current partner will then be lower, because the part for your ex partner is deducted.

When will you get your pension?

At PCN we do our best to pay out your pension benefit each month around the same date. It is deposited to your account on the 21st of the month at the latest. Has it not been deposited by then? In that case, we request you to contact us.

UPAH Bonaire

Union di Penshonado pa Adelanto i Hustisia (UPAH) Bonaire is the association of pensioners. Together with UPAH Curaçao, UPAH Bonaire forms the UPAH.
